DAY

1

One and Done

Let's start this week off right by taking initiative. Pick three rooms in your house that can use some cleaning. Grab a timer and set it for one minute. Look around the room and take initiative by seeing what needs done and doing it until the timer runs out! Do this for each room you choose. If you don't know what to do, ask an adult. Bonus points if you do more rooms!

Look for ways that you can take initiative at home this week.

DAY

2

Bring Others In

Nehemiah saw what needed to be done and did it. He also brought others with him to help. Grab a friend or family member, think of something you can do for a neighbor, your community or a friend and do it together. Think of something small and simple that you can complete today!

Ask God to show you other's needs.

DAY

3

Lift Off

Make a Paper Rocket

1. Grab a piece of paper and something to write with.
2. Practice your verse aloud a few times, then write this week's verse on a piece of paper and fold it into a paper rocket (airplane).
3. Send it into orbit!

Know that even though you are young you can help others in big ways.

DAY

4

Initiate Prayer

Go ask someone in your house to pray with you! It is always nice to pray with someone else. You can talk about what you would like to pray about or you can read the example verse below.

“Dear God, I pray that we can work together to do the right thing. To see what needs to be done and do it. Give us opportunities to make a difference. Amen.”
